

- 1€ Bn to support <u>research</u>: site policy, attractiveness of high-level researchers, support for infrastructures;
- 500€ M for cross-functional support for technology maturation and clinical trials;
- 2€ Bn for acceleration strategies for <u>biotherapy and bioproduction of innovative</u> therapies, digital health, emerging infectious diseases and CBRN threats
- 1.5€ Bn to support <u>industrial investment</u> through calls for projects and the European IPCEI project;
- 2€ Bn to support the emergence, growth and industrialization of start-ups by Bpifrance;
- 400 € M for the medical devices sector.

5TH LARGEST MARKET WORLDWIDE

- Pharma: €62 billion in revenue in 2020 (exports = 50%). 100,000 employees. €7.3 billion invested in R&D.
- Medtech: €31 billion in revenue in 2021 (exports = €10 billion). 1,500 companies and 90,000 direct employees.
- A unique social protection system, ensuring easy access to healthcare for **67 million people**. The French universal health insurance covers **77%** of health expenditure, **with OOP spending being the lowest among OECD countries.**

A STRONG ECOSYSTEM FOR INNOVATION

- 13 Nobel prizes in medicine.
- 2,000 healthtech startups employing 50,000 people, including **750 biotech companies.**
- **€2,3 billion funds raised** by healthtech companies in 2021. **A 50% increase** between 2020 and 2021.
- A leading country for **clinical trials in oncology, rare diseases and biotherapies**. France is involved in 45% of clinical trials in oncology / 30% worldwide.



A FLAGSHIP FISCAL SCHEME: THE FRENCH **R&D TAX CREDIT**

- → Possibility to deduct R&D expenditure of 30% up to €100 million in expenditures, 5% above this threshold.
- → €800 million of R&D tax credit per year for the healthcare industry.
- → France is ranked first among OECD countries for R&D funding.

SUPPORT FOR THE HEALTH SECTOR IN 2021



€1.2 billion in incentives have been allocated to this sector to support nearly 850 projects. More than four times as much as in 2020.

Healthtech companies received 33% of total incentives in 2021.

Since the beginning of the crisis, the State has financed **up to €856m** the companies fighting against Covid (vaccines, diagnostics, therapeutics).

Equity investments by BPI France with €158m invested in the capital of HealthTech companies and €205m in HealthTech venture capital funds in 2021.
