SMEs make up 90% of businesses worldwide and employ over 2 billion people.


NEED FOR ADAPTATION








- Disclose our progress on a yearly basis


In doing so, we are proud to be recognised by the United Nations Race to Zero campaign, and join governments, businesses, cities, regions, and universities around the world that share the same mission.


Growing range of support and incentives

Every business that makes the SME Climate Commitment will be recognized by the **United Nations' Race to Zero campaign**.




We are developing more support and financial incentives, which will be added to the SME Climate Hub in 2022 and 2023.


Coming soon- SME Reporting Tool v.1.0




have partnered to enable SMEs to report on emissions through a simple tool, summarizing annual emissions including actions and impact of emission reduction efforts
