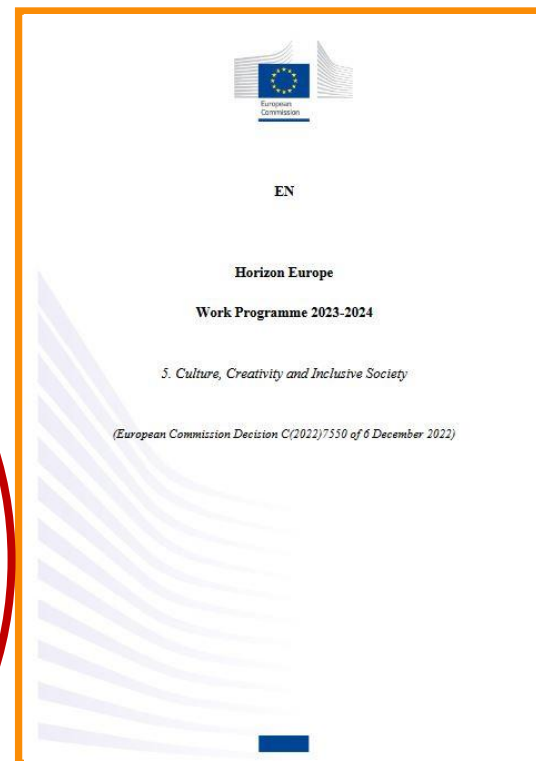

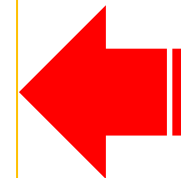

<i>Indicative budget</i>	The total indicative budget for the topic is EUR 9.00 million.
<i>Type of Action</i>	Research and Innovation Actions
<i>Eligibility conditions</i>	The conditions are described in General Annex B. The following exceptions apply: The <u>Joint Research Centre (JRC)</u> may participate as member of the consortium selected for funding.

Expected Outcome: Projects should contribute to all of the following expected outcomes:

- Practical understanding of the role and evolution of all forms of opposition (protest, cultural opposition, non-compliance, subversion, activism), their different platforms (physical and online), and their impact on democracy, including in resisting the rise of authoritarian tendencies and in taking down authoritarian regimes.
- Policy recommendations based on a deep analysis of the potential shift from traditional party structures to social mobilisation and activism as means for democratic participation, including drivers and factors that might play a role in fostering such forms of politics.

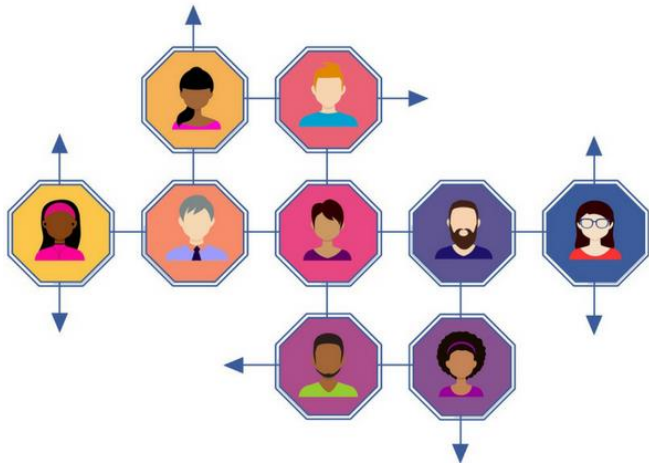

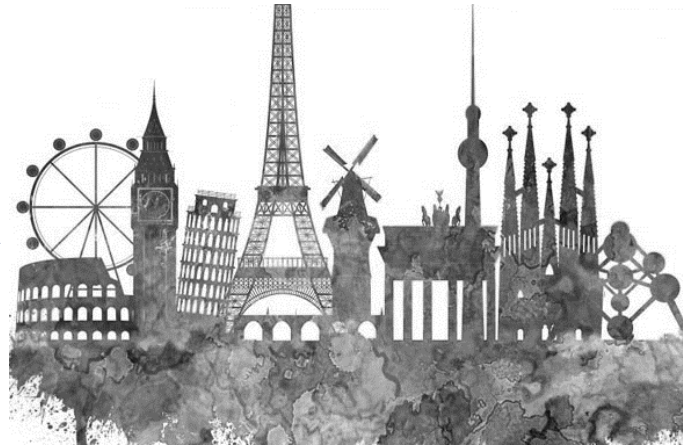

RESEARCH AND INNOVATION TO FIGHT CORRUPTION

WHAT IS CORRUPTION?

Corruption is a multi-faceted phenomenon, present both in the public and private sectors, and linked to decision-making in business management, public administration, and politics. Corruption has many forms. It can be petty crime or complex high-level corruption but it can also hide behind favouritism and nepotism, conflicts of interest and revolving doors – where business meets politics.

Corruption is a threat to security as it enables and drives organised and other serious crime. Almost 60% of criminal groups engage in corruption, with some of these groups applying a "business strategy" to frequently and proactively target sector-specific business managers or public servants. Corruption and organised crime are almost inextricably linked with its targets ranging from public officials, law enforcement officials, politically exposed persons, members of the judiciary and the private sector.



Corruption creates business uncertainty, lowers investment levels and prevents the single market from operating smoothly. Most importantly, corruption undermines trust in democracy, public institutions and governments, and constitutes a serious threat to the rule of law and fundamental rights.

A serious concern for citizens

The 2022 Eurobarometer on corruption shows that corruption remains a serious concern for EU citizens and businesses in the EU. Almost seven in ten Europeans (69%) believe that corruption is widespread in their country and over four in ten Europeans (41%) consider that the level of corruption has increased in their country. A majority of companies (51%) think that it is unlikely that corrupt people or businesses in their country would be caught, or reported to the police or prosecutors.

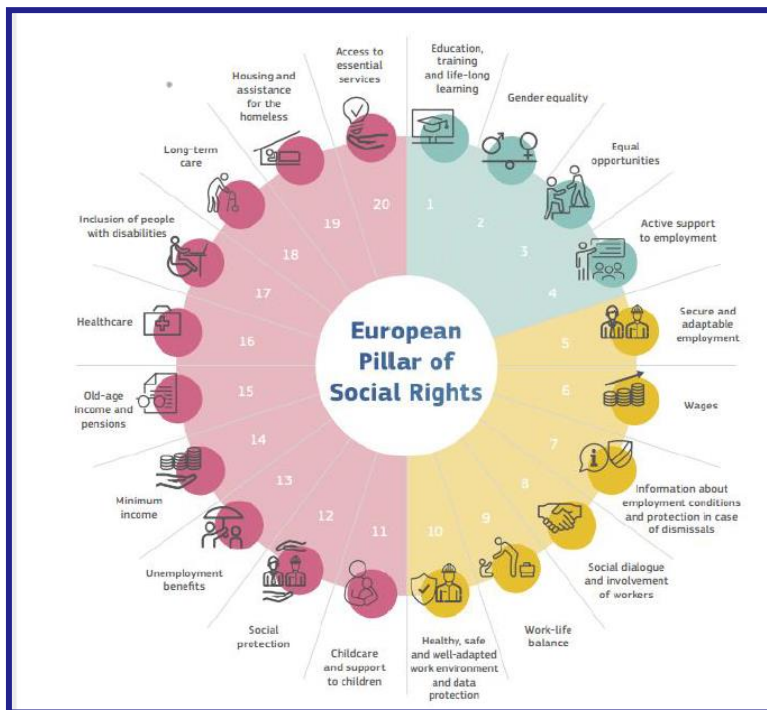

Net4SocietyHE (N4SHE) is the transnational network for Cluster 2 "Culture, Creativity and Inclusive Society" (CL2) National Contact Points (NCPs) in Horizon Europe. NCPs are officially designated to advise researchers and other relevant, eligible stakeholders in their efforts to secure EU funding. N4SHE builds on Net4Society, the network for Societal Challenge 6 NCPs in H2020, and NCPs for Socio-economic Sciences and Humanities in FP7 (started in 2008) and will further develop services and tools created by its predecessor to help NCPs to succeed in their work.

To support SSH Integration across Horizon Europe, Net4SocietyHE will organise SSH-themed brokerages, special training on the topic for NCPs, and publish an "SSH Opportunities" document, highlighting SSH research funding chances beyond flagged topics within Horizon Europe, including in missions and partnerships, and separately publicize opportunities in other EU Programmes.

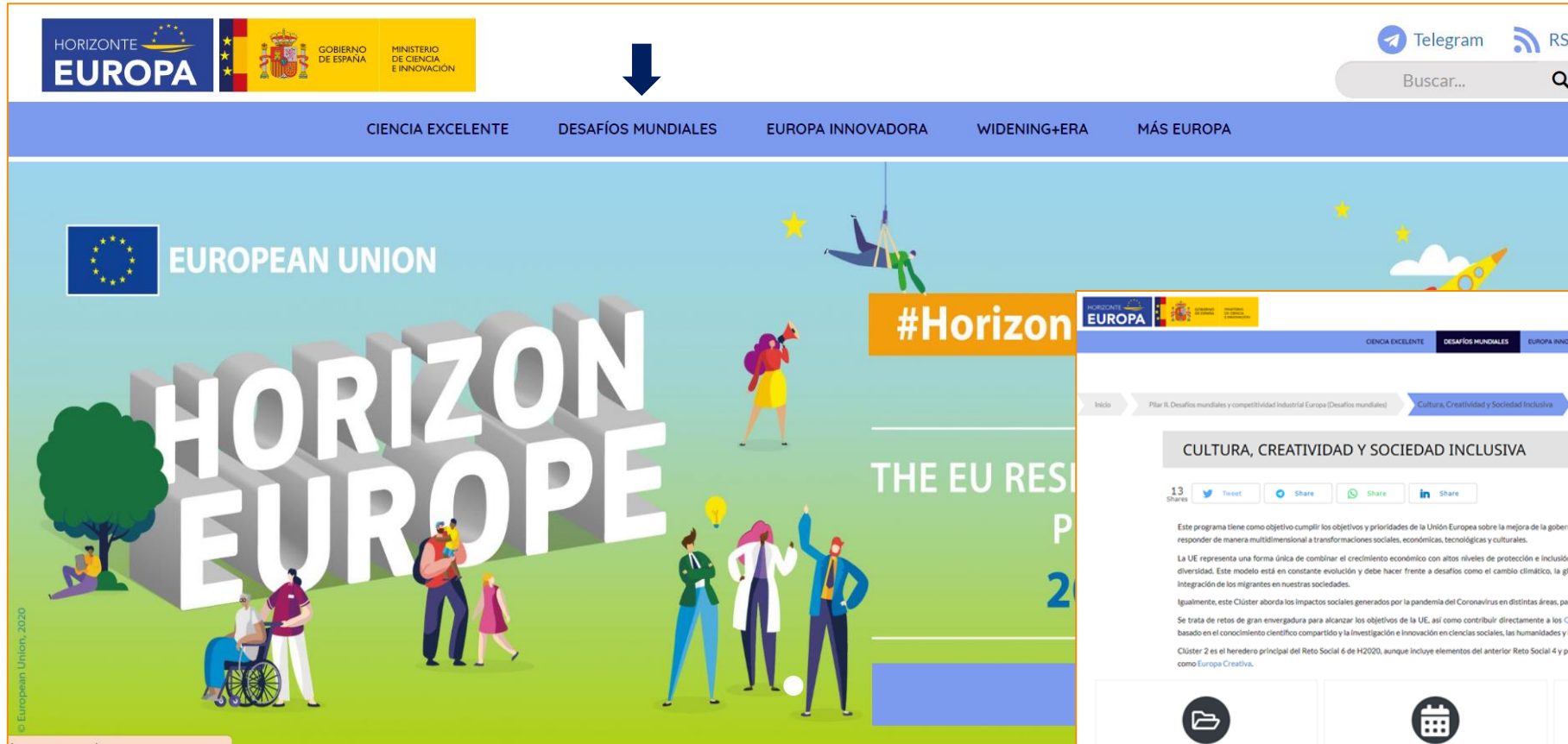
