Scaling Startups Programme Call



Main aspects to consider:

- Programme providing tailored expert support responding to each startup's unique needs.
- Niche exposure to leading EU impact investors: consortium acting as investor' allies.
- Demo Day for investor engagement and co-funding opportunities post-programme.
- De-risk startups growth and investability barriers.



Consortium: Minimum two independent legal entities established in two different EU member states.

Consortium must include, link or engage in its activities early-stage investors focused on mobility, smart cities, sustainability, and impact investment



Mandatory elements: KPIs EITHE3.1 (10 Supported startups); EITHE6.1 (1M€ of investment attracted by supported startups) and contribution to EIT Urban Mobility Financial Sustainability Mechanism (FSM).

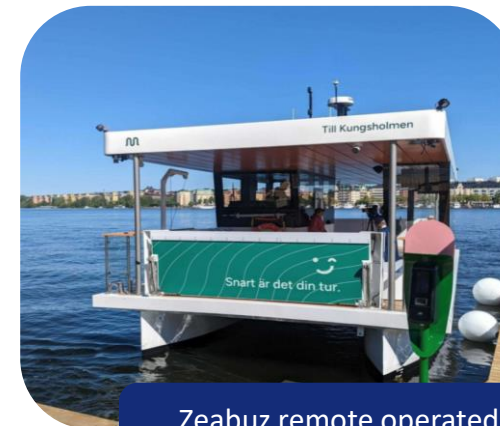

Differences of our Innovation Programme with Horizon Europe



Innovations

Horizon Europe	EIT Urban Mobility Innovation Programme
Bigger (3-7M€)	Smaller budgets (40K – 2M€)
longer projects (3 years)	6–24month projects
Large consortia (>10 partners)	Mono-beneficiary or small consortia (2-5 partners)
Lower TRLs	TRL 6 and above
Commercialisation is one of the options for medium to long term exploitation, but not the only one	Capable of generating a sales track record at project end

- CATEGORY A:** EIT Urban Mobility and partners will **submit jointly**, in an arrangement in which EIT Urban Mobility is an active partner;

- CATEGORY C:** EIT Urban Mobility **provides a letter of support but** is not involved in the project or proposal development.

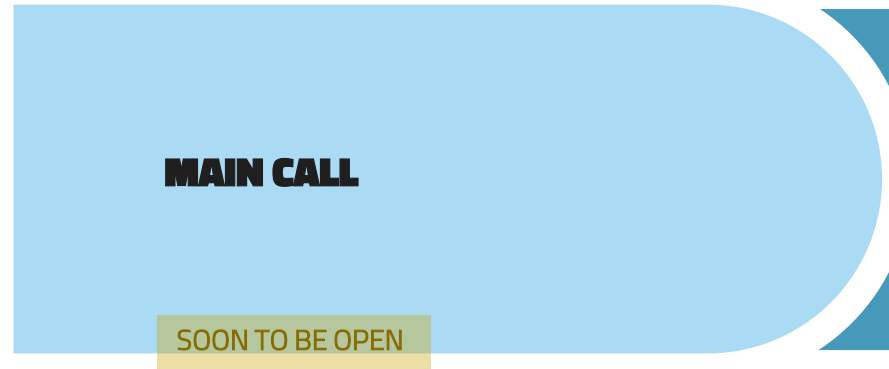

Main aspects to consider: Seeking new innovations that tackle the **most pressing urban mobility challenges**. Solutions should demonstrate **strong potential for scalability and market adoption**. Projects should foster **collaborative innovation** – whether across the value chain or other strategic partnerships- with a **clear pathway to market deployment** by the project's end.



Consortium: Minimum of 2 partners from 2 different EU Member States or associated countries to HE.



Mandatory elements: KPIs EITHE2.4 (marketed innovation) or EITHE4.4 (startup created); minimum 35% co-funding and contribution to EIT Urban Mobility Financial Sustainability Mechanism (FSM).



Start date: Jan-Feb 2026



Project duration: up to 24 months



Budget: up to 1M€ per year

RAPTOR and SME Market Expansion Open Calls



Main aspects to consider:

- **SME Market Expansion Call:** Supports the supply of urban mobility innovations by helping SMEs test, improve, and commercialise solutions with real-world end-client validation (min. TRL 7)
- **City RAPTOR:** Addresses the demand for urban mobility solutions by rapidly developing and piloting innovations that solve city-defined challenges through direct collaboration with cities



Consortium: Mono beneficiary – for startups and SMEs from EU Member States or associated countries to HE



Mandatory elements: KPIs EITHE2.4 (marketed innovation); and contribution to EIT Urban Mobility Financial Sustainability Mechanism (FSM).
