What is the Department for International Trade (DIT)?

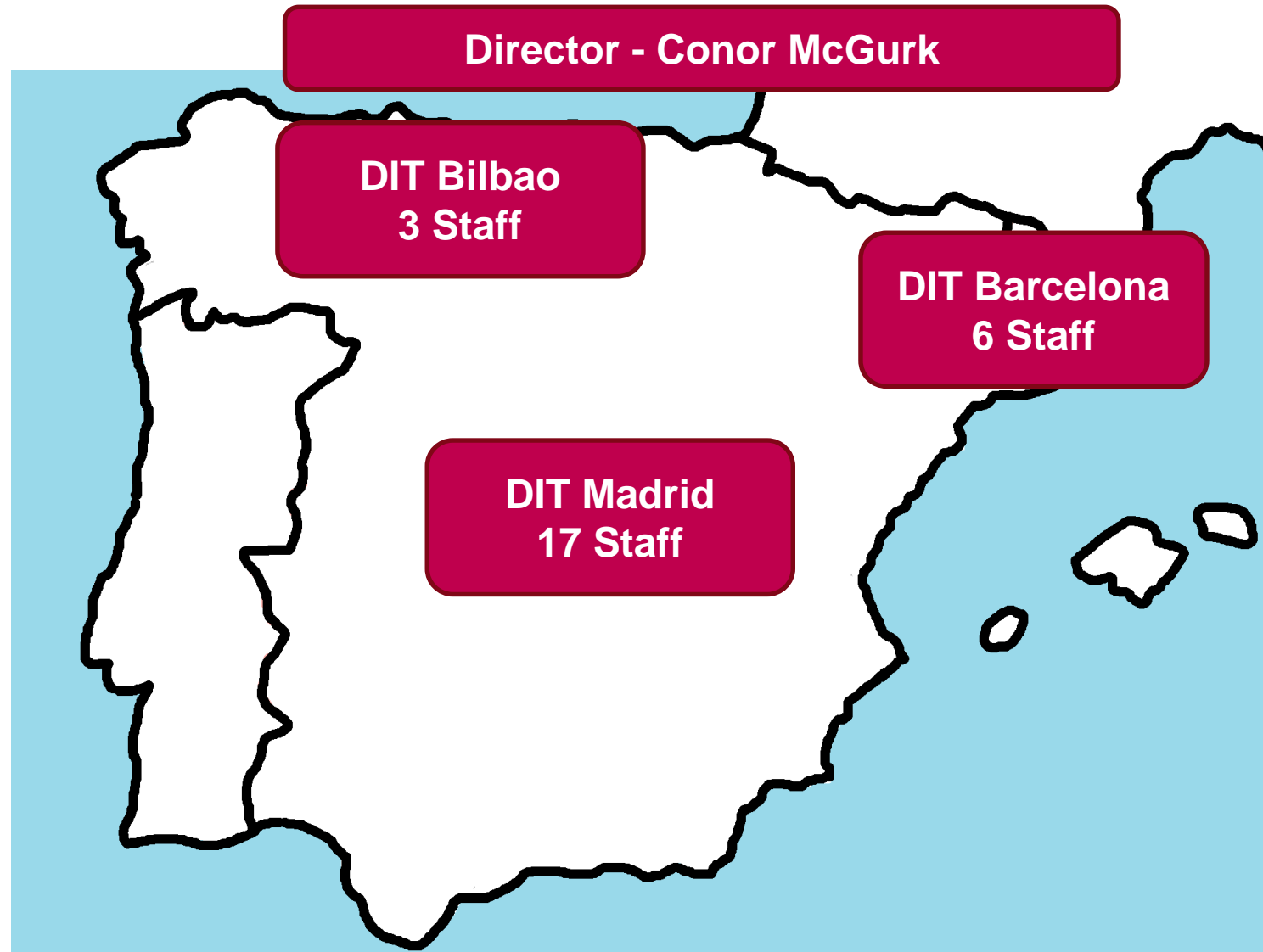
DIT is the UK government department that has overall responsibility for promoting UK trade across the world, and attracting subsidiaries of overseas companies to the UK.
