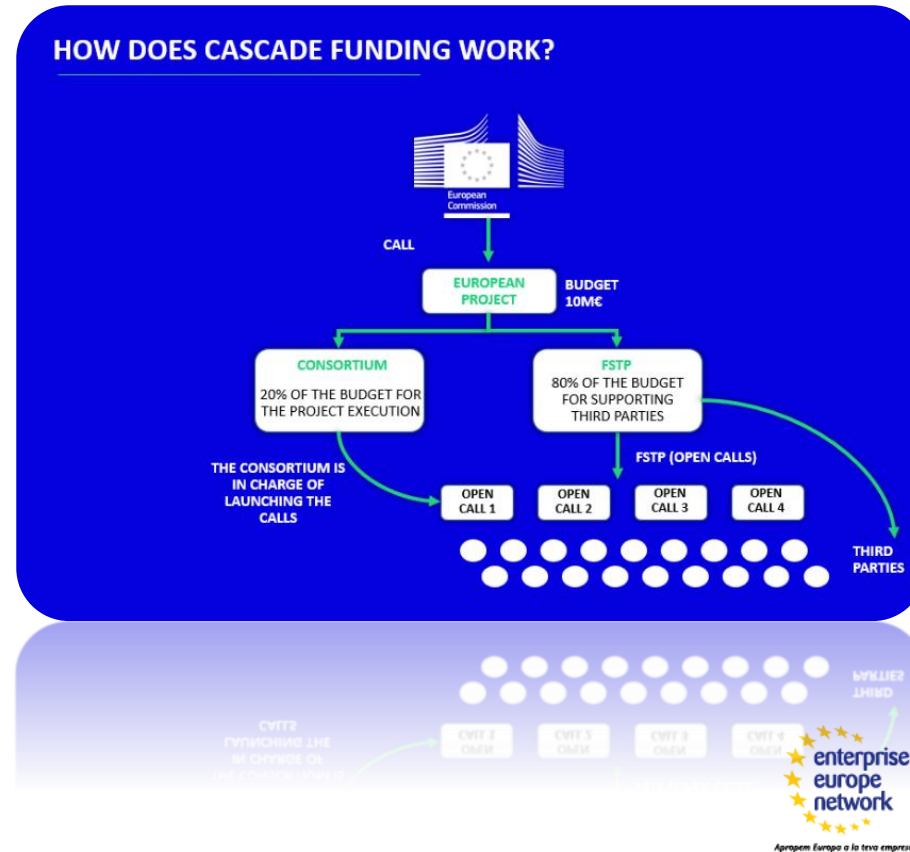

Què és el finançament en cascada europeu?

És un mecanisme que permet als **beneficiaris d'un projecte europeu oferir suport financer a entitats externes**, com pimes, startups o centres de recerca, per **dur a terme activitats que contribueixin als objectius del projecte**, sense que aquestes entitats signin el conveni de subvenció ni formen part del consorci.



Qui és elegible per al finançament en cascada?

Dependrà dels criteris de participació segons les convocatòries de finançament.



Convocatòries obertes a **totes les organitzacions**, incloent-hi **PIMEs, startups, ONG, universitats i entitats públiques**.



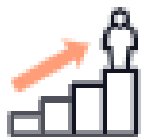
Convocatòries **restringides només als socis del consorci**.



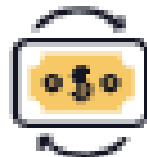
Elegibilitat limitada a **organitzacions dels països socis**.

Quantitats de finançament flexibles, des de 10.000 € fins a 300.000 €, generalment entre 50.000 € i 150.000 €



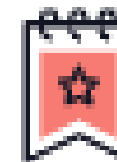
Accés a programes d'incubació, acceleració, mentoria i xarxes internacionals

The support to third parties can only be provided in the form of grants. Financial support provided by the participants to third parties is one of the primary activities of the action in order to be able to achieve its objectives.</p> <p>As financial support provided by the participants to third parties is one of the primary activities of the action in order to be able to achieve its objectives, the EUR 60 000 threshold provided for in Article 208(a) of the Financial Regulation does not apply.</p> <p>Given the type of action and its level of ambition, the maximum amount of FSTP to be granted to an individual third party is EUR 3 million, per grant. However, if the objectives of the action would otherwise be impossible or overly difficult (and duly justified in the proposal) the maximum amount may be higher.</p> <p>The funding rate is up to 30% of the eligible costs.</p>

The 6th REINFORCING Open Call (Incubators Call) on "Responsible Innovation" seeks to support projects that promote Open and Responsible Research and Innovation (ORRI) within institutions across Europe. This call is part of the broader REINFORCING initiative, which aims to foster inclusive innovation and societal engagement in research processes by providing financial support to selected projects.

Type of projects to be funded: The call supports large-scale projects that implement ORRI activities. These projects are expected to initiate institutional change and promote responsible research and innovation practices.

Sectors / domain: The focus is on sectors involved in research and innovation, particularly those undergoing green and digital transitions.

Individual or consortium: This call is aimed at consortia requiring at least two beneficiaries per consortium. The consortia must include at least one newcomer to ORRI, who should lead the project.

Specific eligibility requirements: Applicants must be legal entities such as Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs), Higher Education Institutions, Research Centres, or SMEs. They must be established in EU countries or associated countries eligible for Horizon Europe grants.

Specific topics or challenges: The call targets projects that aim to implement new modes of responsible research and innovation, driving more equitable transitions.

Projects duration: Projects are expected to have a fixed duration of 12 months.

Budget, funding rates and payment conditions:

Funding rate: 100% of eligible costs.

Budget conditions / limitations: Up to €60,000 per project.

Payments: Funds are provided as a lump sum.
